



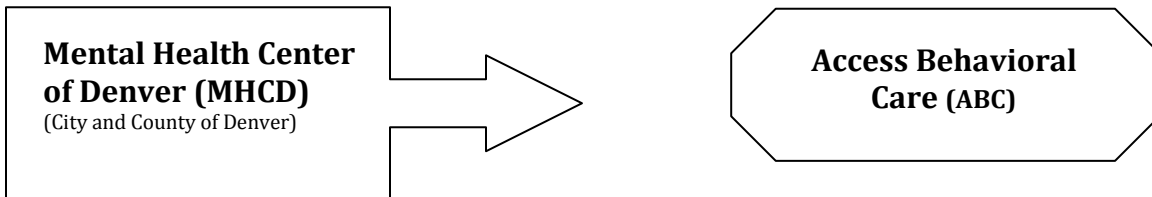

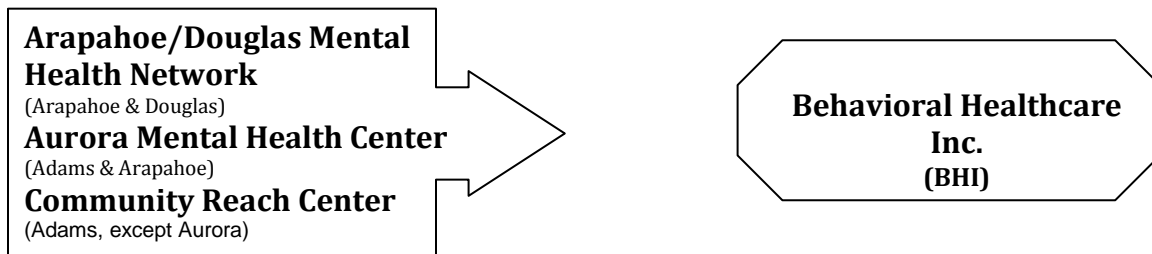

BHOs

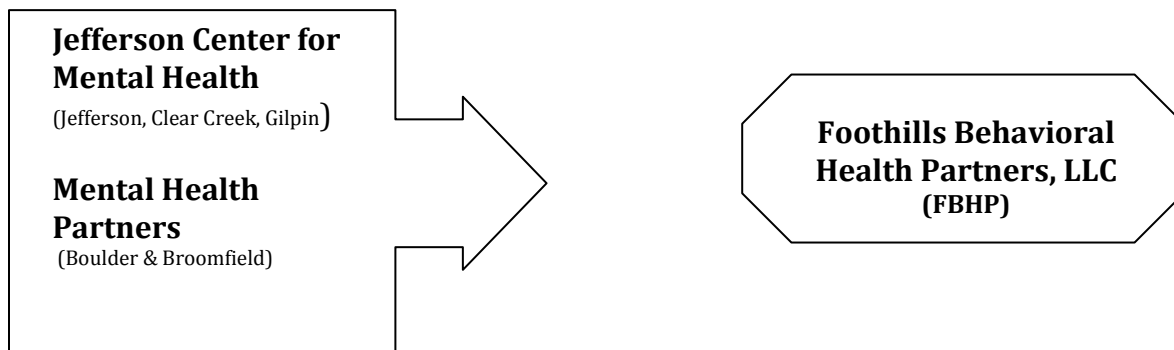
Access Behavioral Care (ABC), is a division of a not-for-profit HMO, Colorado Access. Access Behavioral Care is a nonprofit organization of providers for mental health services for Medicaid consumers in Denver County.



BHI or Behavioral HealthCare, Inc. is a non-profit Managed Care Company that holds the Medicaid Mental Health contract in Arapahoe, Adams, and Douglas Counties, including the City of Aurora.

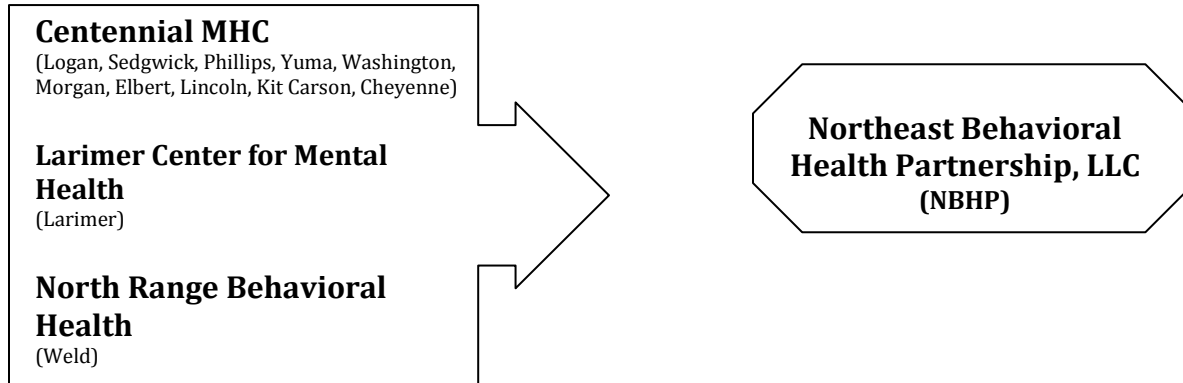


Foothills Behavioral Health Partners, LLC (FBHP) manages mental health benefits for persons enrolled in the Colorado Medicaid program and living in Boulder, Broomfield, Clear Creek, Gilpin and Jefferson Counties.





Northeast Behavioral Health Partnership, LLC (NBHP) is the state-designated Behavioral Healthcare Organization operating to ensure the mental health treatment needs of Medicaid recipients in 12 counties of northeast Colorado are fully met.



Colorado Health Partnerships, LLC dba Colorado Health Networks (CHN) is comprised of providers, eight Community Mental Health Centers and ValueOptions, the leading public sector managed behavioral healthcare organization in the country. This Partnership includes three provider-owned LLCs: Pikes Peak Medicaid LLC, SyCare LLC and West Slope Casa LLC. These three LLCs encompass eight community mental health centers with responsibility for community mental health services in 43 counties.
