

The Cripple Creek-Victor Mountain Health Center (CCV MHC) school-based health center is located at Cresson Elementary in the school nurse's office. This important initiative is in partnership with Peak Vista Community Health Centers, the Cripple Creek-Victor School District, Cripple Creek Counseling Center and AspenPointe Health Services. AspenPointe Health Services colocates a child and family clinician to treat the mental health needs of the school districts' children. Referrals are received from teachers, school-based nurse and counselors

Program Type

- Collaboration On-Site (Behavioral and primary care provided at a shared facility School-Based Health Center).
- Direct Clinical Service; Consultation; Referrals
- The health center serves approximately 500 students and their siblings (aged 0-21) within the Cripple Creek-Victor School District.

Operational Resources

- Cresson Elementary School provides a room for a mental health clinician provided by AspenPointe Health Services to deliver individual therapy.
- All behavioral health clinical care occurs through the AspenPointe Health Services IT system including charting and record keeping.
- Each organization provides the necessary supports to ensure that access to the clients' primary or behavioral health records is available.
- > Each entity is responsible for the supervision, technical resources and operational supplies to support the healthcare delivered by its staff.

Fiscal Resources

The clinical services are able to be supported through Medicaid and Colorado Department of Behavioral Health Block Grant.
