

Jefferson Center for Mental Health (Jefferson Center) collaborates with the Metro Community Provider Network (MCPN), to provide regular onsite behavioral health services at MCPN Arvada and Jefferson County clinics. These services are provided by a behavioral health professional and include assessment, focused interventions, prevention, wellness and clinical consultation. 2.5 FTE behavioral health professionals are on site at the Jefferson County and Arvada clinics serving both children and adults.

Program Type

- Collaboration on-site in an integrated system (behavioral health provider at a primary care FOHC).
- MCPN and Jefferson Center staffs are currently participating in an integrated care learning community with National Council for Community Behavioral Health and Mental Health Corporations of America with the hope of ultimately expanding services to a fully integrated model.
- Direct Clinical Service; Consultation; Referrals
- ➤ For calendar year 2010 Jefferson Center provided 1,176 services to 545 patients at the 2 MCPN clinics. This does not include clinical consultation to providers at each of the clinics and other contacts that were not electronically recorded.
- Patients receiving services by payor at MCPN includes: 62% indigent, 19% Medicaid, 9% Medicare, and 10% other.
