

Clinicians from Larimer Center for Mental Health (LCMH) spend 18 hours per week at the Salud Family Health Center, a Federally Qualified Health Center (FQHC), in Fort Collins, Colorado. The goal is to attend to Medicaid clients who may feel more comfortable receiving their mental health care in a primary care setting than in the mental health clinic.

Program Type

- Collaboration On-Site (Mental health on-site on a limited basis in a Federally Qualified Health Center).
- Direct Clinical Service; Referrals
- ➤ LCMH provides an Early Childhood Specialist for ten hours per week to serve children ages 0-5 and their families.
- > LCMH provides direct services to adults for eight hours per week.

Operational Resources

- > Salud Family Health Centers Fort Collins Clinic provides the facility and related supports to ensure that access to the clients' primary health record is available.
- ➤ Larimer Center for Mental Health is responsible for the supervision, technical resources and opetational supplies to support the behavioral healthcare delivered by its co-located staff.

Fiscal Resources

Early Childhood services are funded through LCMH's General Fund contract with the state of Colorado.
