Under direct supervision of Nurse Manger or designee, provides care, assessment, treatment and support services to consumers and/or their families, including planning, implementation and documentation. Operates in an inpatient detox environment, Residential or in an outreach environment, such as in homes, schools, and/or outpatient clinic at a site designated by Nurse Manager, Director of Nursing, or Medical Director.

- Assess needs of client, develop solutions and ensure implementation of solutions/interventions and programs to meet those identified needs.
- Observes, identifies, monitors, reports and records the condition of the client including signs and symptoms which may be indicative of change in the consumer's condition to appropriate members of the treatment team (includes treating psychiatrist and clinical staff), supervising RN.
- Provides assistance in crisis intervention, as needed. If assesses situation to be emergent; calls crisis team, 911 and notifies doctor and manager/supervisor.
- Acts as a liaison to outside agencies and providers for clients to ensure continuity of care. In this the capacity advocates for client's needs, ensures care provided and ensures necessary follow-up.
- Possess effective communication skills that promote a collaborative and positive team environment, and ability to communicate with people of diverse socioeconomic and cultural origins.
- Attends and participates in group sessions, in-services education and training opportunities, meetings and special events.
- Responsible for admission and discharge process to Program according to CRC Medical/DetoxServices protocol/policy.
