Proposal Timetable:

Timely submission of the papers is critical to inclusion in the program. The procedures and timetable enumerated below will apply.

Deadline for Proposals
 All session proposals must be submitted by April 15, 2018. However, you are encouraged to submit a proposal sooner.

2. Acceptance of Proposals

By **May 1, 2018**, the Committee will make a decision on all proposals. The number of accepted proposals is limited to the current available sessions. The Committee will contact authors regarding their proposals.

Submission Guidelines:

Session proposals should be prepared in accordance with the formatting section below. All submissions should include the following:

- Name, email address and phone number of the presenter
- Up to a 75-word bio of the presenter
- Presenter's CV/Resume (including presentation skills and video or CD of a prior presentation if available*)
- Proposed session title
- Length of session (60 minutes, 90 minutes, 2 90-minute session)
- 50-word session abstract/description
- Full description of proposed session (with outline or power point if available)
- Include outcome and learning objectives for the session attendees
- Describe your presentation style and the format of this specific session
- Requested compensation, if applicable (including honorarium, travel reimbursement & hotel accommodations) *

**If the presenter is an employee of a CBHC member it is expected that there would no fees and any costs for speaking would be picked up by that member.

The Planning Committee looks forward to receiving proposals in response to the call, and is happy to respond to inquiries from interested parties.
