REWIND Program Purpose and Vision:

To divert juveniles from the municipal court system and intervene quicker, sooner, faster and implement interventions and resources for better outcomes. We know that youth have greater capacity for change and want to leverage this potential.

Goals:

- Provide early intervention
- Decrease the time in the system
- Reduce recidivism

Benefits:

- ✓ Resources earlier
- ✓ Alleviate arresting the same youth until they receive higher level intervention (decrease "frequent flyers")
- ✓ Address resource barriers on front lines
