



CBHC 2022 - Ambulatory Withdrawal Management: You CAN Try This at Home!

Needs:

- Increased use of fentanyl by the patient population has resulted in more challenging outpatient withdrawal scenarios and more complicated inductions with MAT
- Lack of outpatient support when severity does NOT meet criteria for inpatient detoxification
- Overall increased substance use and overdose rates across Colorado since onset of COVID in the spring of 2020

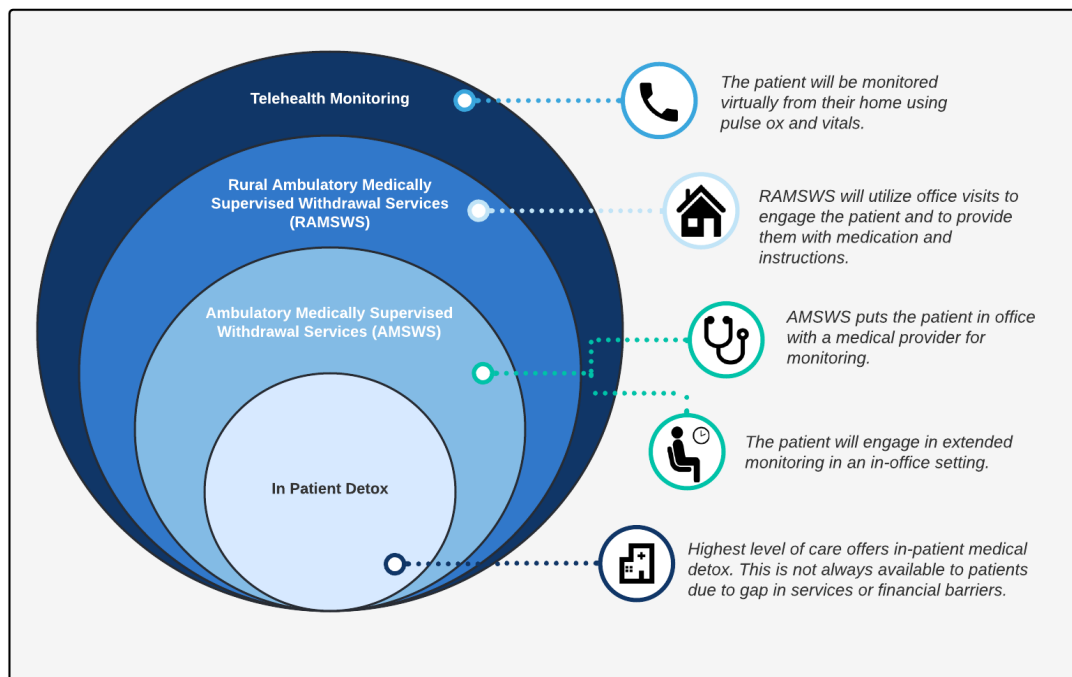
FRC Outpatient Solutions: New platforms to deliver outpatient withdrawal services

Home based with extended medical support & supervision

- **RAMSWS:** Rural Ambulatory Medically Supervised Withdrawal Services
 - Direct one-on-one assessment with a medical provider during the day
 - Access to post-clinic medical diagnostic tools & medical extender outside of standard clinic hours
 - Individualized treatment plans
 - Access to medications for withdrawal management
 - Medications for Addiction Treatment (MAT)
 - Access to online support systems

Office-based with extended medical support & supervision

- **AMSWS:** Ambulatory Medically Supervised Withdrawal Services
 - All of the above
 - Added component of extended in-house monitoring to help with withdrawal and induction services'
 - Wrap around services



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
