

## Court Ordered - Assertive Community Treatment (CO-ACT) with WellPower

CO-ACT is a diversion program funded by a four-year, \$4MM SAMSHA grant in which people who are experiencing severe mental illness are eligible to have their criminal charges dismissed upon being certified to treatment and entering the CO-ACT program with WELLPOWER. Entering the CO-ACT program allows people to focus on their mental health treatment opposed to dealing with their criminal court requirements. The goal is for people to remain in the program for one year and determine, with the participant, a treatment plan, set expectations of Probate Court, and explain how we'll proceed to meet and maintain the participant's needs.

**What CO-ACT Provides:** Each participant in our program will be assigned a Clinical Case Manager, Psychiatrist, and Therapist as well as the option to work with a Peer Specialist and Employment Specialist. The goals of treatment will focus on meeting participants' basic needs for housing, food, clothes, proper medical care, etc., and maintaining psychiatric stability to help participants achieve their life goals and avoid further contact with the criminal justice system.

### CO-ACT Program Requirements:

1. Maintaining the Certification requirements including the following:
  - Staying on Prescribed Medications
  - Minimum of 1 Case Management Contact per Week
  - 1 Psychiatry Appointment per Month
  - 2 Therapy/Behavioral Health Sessions per Month
2. Remaining in contact with the case manager and treatment team even if certification requirements are not being met.
